

# Spill Prevention, Control and Countermeasures (SPCC) Plans

Industrial facilities are subject to numerous environmental compliance requirements, including the Spill Prevention, Control and Countermeasures (SPCC) rule, which is administered by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (US EPA) under 40 CFR Part 112. The SPCC rule requires that engineering controls be implemented to ensure oil does not enter navigable waters of the United States.

Sierra creates SPCC plans for a variety of facilities and also works with clients to determine operational and management techniques to reduce oil storage capacity at facilities so that a formal SPCC plan is not required.

### Large Beverage Manufacturer – Nationwide

In addition to SPCC preparation, Compliance Verification Visits (CVV) have been conducted at the facilities to ensure that recommended corrective actions have been implemented to maintain compliance with SPCC regulations. ### Trucking Terminals – Multiple Locations – southeastern United States

The goal was to make each SPCC plan comply with the specific needs of the facility, but allow for uniformity at the corporate level. Training was conducted during the SPCC site visit and a copy provided to the client for their use in conducting training to new employees as well as annual refresher trainings. Ongoing training is also provided via teleconference after the plan is completed, to assure that facility personnel are informed as to their particular assignments.
